

## Knights Challenge

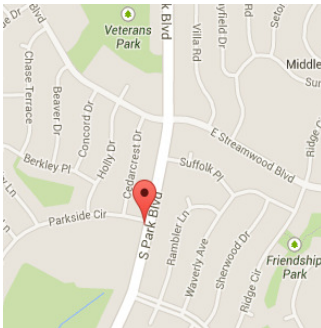
