Knights Serve Our World

Together, members of the Knights of Columbus improved the world through remarkable achievements and staggering numbers last year:

- \$170 million is the amount raised and distributed to the Church, community, youth and fellowman.
- 70.5 million volunteer hours in service through the "Surge... With Service" outreach program.
- More than \$95 Billion of Insurance has been issued to Knights and their families.
- \$52.8 million from the "Knights of Columbus Vicarius Christi" fund was conveyed to the Holy Father for his charities, since 1981.
- Support for Special Olympics continued over the past year, during which more than 107,000 Knights volunteered 315,000 hours of their time at various Special Olympic events, KOC donated \$46 million since 2001.
- Since 1981 \$63 million donated in aid to more than 100,000 men and women pursuing their vocations to religious life.
- Nearly 20,000 wheelchairs provided to people with disabilities worldwide since 2003.
- Supported Pro-Life with \$10.5 million for their projects
