Covid Vaccine updates

Phase 1b eligible individuals (those 65 years or older, and front-line essential workers including law enforcement officers, food and agricultural workers, postal service workers, manufacturing workers, grocery store workers, public transit workers, and those in the educational sector including teachers, support staff and daycare workers) can now schedule COVID-19 vaccine appointments at vaccine.cookcountyil.gov. Individuals without internet access or who need assistance scheduling can call (833) 308-1988 (from 7:00 am -7:00 pm, Monday - Friday). **Cook County Health will only offer appointment slots based on the amount of vaccine on hand and will add appointments as new vaccine shipments arrive.**
